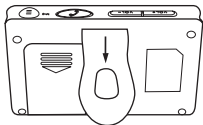


LCD Caller Display

SPEAKERPHONE VISOR CLIP INSTALLATION

The Speakerphone is equipped with clips to attach to your vehicle's visors. To mount your Speakerphone to your Visor:

- Attached Speakerphone clips to vehicle's sun visor

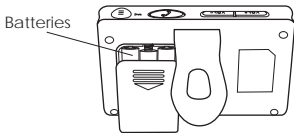

BATTERY OPERATIONS

IMPORTANT: Before using the Speakerphone:

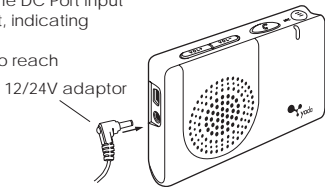
- Charge the batteries for 6 hours
- Only use rechargeable batteries provided



Charge the Hands-Free Speakerphone using 12/24V Vehicle DC Port

Follow the steps below when charging the Speakerphone:

- Plug 12/24V adaptor to vehicle cigarette lighter socket
- Connect adapter to Speakerphone DC Port input
- Verify LED shows a steady red light, indicating device is charging
- Recharge the device for 4 hours to reach full capacity (6 hours if first use)
- Device LED red light will turn off and LED blue light will turn on indicating battery is fully charged



! **IMPORTANT:** Remove device from DC adapter before leaving the vehicle. Do not leave device charging in the vehicle unattended.

NOTE: Actual talk time and standby time for the Speakerphone will vary with different Bluetooth® mobile phones due to different implementation of power down modes.

Low Battery Indicator

Recharge the Speakerphone immediately after the low battery indicators are detected. When battery power is low:

1. The red LED will flash
2. The speakerphone will beep every two minutes

The Speakerphone automatically powers off once batteries are completely consumed. The device will not power back on unless the batteries are sufficiently charged. It may take several minutes before the LED light turns back on once connected for recharging.

Blue 1 x 3 sec.	Ready – can be accessed by paired devices

Red/Blue Blinking	Pairing-Mode

SPEAKERPHONE OPERATIONS

Power On/Off

To turn Speakerphone on:

- Press and hold "On/Off" for 2 seconds until LED light turns blue
- Listen for a long tone indicating the Speakerphone is powered up
- Blue LED will flash every 3 seconds to indicate device is powered on

To turn Speakerphone off:

- Press and hold "On/Off" for 5 seconds until LED light turns off
- Listen for a long tone indicating the Speakerphone is powered down

The Speakerphone will automatically power off to save battery power if disconnected from the Bluetooth® link for an hour.



Pairing/Linking

Pairing Bluetooth® enabled devices like mobile phones with the Speakerphone authorizes the devices to work with each. This step only needs to be performed once.

Before Pairing the Speakerphone:

- Ensure the Speakerphone is fully charged
- Charging cable is disconnected
- The Speakerphone is turned off (see steps for turning off device)
- You have the pairing instruction of your Bluetooth® wireless phone

It is recommended that you follow the pairing instructions provided by your mobile phone to ensure you successfully pair the Speakerphone with your mobile phone. If you do not have your mobile phone's instruction manual available, follow the typical pairing instructions below:

- Press and hold "On/Off" until device gives a double tone
- LED will flash alternating red and blue light indicating the Speakerphone is in Pairing Mode
- Turn on your mobile phone
- Select setup or connect from your mobile phone menu
- Find and select option to discover Bluetooth® devices, establishing a connection may take several minutes
- If found, phone display should indicate YD-V2 device was detected
- Phone should give you prompt asking if you want to pair the device
- Select "OK" and wait for prompt to enter passkey or PIN
- Enter the code 0000
- Check the Speakerphone LED for a flashing blue light every 3 seconds to verify the pairing was successful
- Do not change the Speakerphone name if the phone gives you a prompt to change the name, accept YD-V2 as the name of the device

Red and Blue light

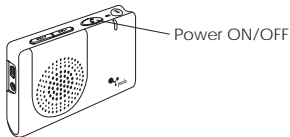


If the mobile phone failed to detect the Speakerphone and did not successfully pair

- Turn the Speakerphone and phone off, wait for 10 seconds
- Turn phone power on
- Repeat the pairing instructions from the beginning

Establishing Bluetooth® Link:

You will need to establish a link between the Speakerphone and your mobile phone before you can make or receive any calls. Follow instructions provided by your mobile phone to ensure you can establish a successful link. If you do not have your mobile phone operating instructions available, follow the typical steps below:



- Press "On/Off"
- Depending on your mobile phone, the link will either be established automatically and the LED status should have a blue light flashing every 3 seconds indicating the device was linked successfully
- Other mobile phones will give you a prompt to accept the link request from the Speakerphone before establishing a link, select Yes or OK if you get a prompt
- If Speakerphone link is disconnected but power is on, press "On/Off" to establish link again

NOTE: If the Speakerphone is used with multiple wireless device or mobile phones, the device reconnects to the last used device.

Dual Mobile Phone Connection

The Speakerphone can be paired and connect with two mobile phones at the same time. To connect two mobile phones:

- Pair mobile phone 1 with Speakerphone (See pairing instructions above)
- Make sure mobile phone is properly paired before pairing mobile phone 2
- Turn off Speakerphone and wait for 2 seconds, then hold "On/Off" to enter pairing mode
- Pair mobile phone 2 with Speakerphone (See pairing instructions above)
- Establish link mobile phone 2 (See linking instructions above)
- Re-Link mobile phone 1

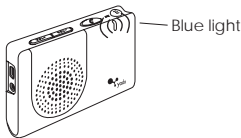
The device will operate with the last connected or activated mobile phone, and automatically switch between each phone.

NOTE: Do not operate Speakerphone while connecting with another mobile phone.

Incoming Calls

To answer calls manually:

- Check if power is on and linked
- Press "On/Off" when incoming call ring is received
- Blue LED light will continue to flash every second while call is in session



Transferring Calls

The Speakerphone is capable of transferring calls from your mobile phone to the Speakerphone and vice-versa. Follow your mobile phone operating instructions to ensure successful transfer of calls between the Speakerphone and your mobile phone. If instructions are not available, use the typical instructions below to transfer your calls:

- Press "On/Off" to transfer a call from the mobile phone to the Speakerphone
- To transfer from the Speakerphone to the mobile phone while in session, follow instruction from your mobile phone

Reject an incoming call

To reject a call:

- Press and hold "On/Off" for 2 seconds while Speakerphone is ringing
- Call should be dropped once long tone is heard

Call Waiting

To answer another incoming call while already in session:

- Press and hold "Volume -" for 2 seconds
- Speakerphone will place the active call on hold and switch the session to the incoming call
- To return to previous call session, press "Volume -" again for 2 seconds

Outgoing Calls

To make a call using voice activated function:

Verify if the mobile phone voice activated function is properly set and Speakerphone is within range of the mobile phone.

- Press "On/Off" and wait for signal tone
- Say recorded voice command set on your mobile phone (e.g. Call "Name of Person")
- Wait a few seconds for call to connect
- Begin call once connected and answered

To Redial last number called

- Press and hold "Volume -" for 2 seconds until a beep tone is heard indicates redial attempt
- Handset will call the last number dialed

Ending Calls

To end the active call:

- Press "On/Off" to disconnect call and listen for long tone
- LED will show a blue light flashing every 3 seconds indicating the device is in stand-by

Volume

To adjust the Speakerphone volume during a call:

- Press "Volume +" to increase Speakerphone speaker volume
- Press "Volume -" to decrease Speakerphone speaker volume
- Speakerphone will give double tone when maximum or minimum volume is reached

To mute the Speakerphone during an active call:

- Press and hold "Volume +" for 2 seconds
- Speakerphone microphone will be muted until removed
- Speakerphone will give periodic beep tone indicating mute function is active

To un-mute Speakerphone:

- Press and hold "Volume +" for 2 seconds
- Speakerphone disables periodic beep
- Mute function is deactivated and Speakerphone is active again

LCD DISPLAY OPERATIONS

Link operation and its LCD display status

The Speakerphone can be paired and connect with two mobile phones at the same time. To connect two mobile phones:



CONNECTED	Displayed after successfully linking the Speakerphone to the mobile phone	
OFF	Displayed on LCD for a few seconds when Speakerphone is turned off. Displayed with LCD off when Speakerphone is still connected with the power on




VOICE OVER INTERNET PROTOCOL (VOIP) APPLICATION

The Speakerphone can be used with desktop or laptop computer that are Bluetooth® compatible, to make call via Voice Over Internet Protocols (VOIP). To use this function, follow the instructions below:

NOTE: If your computer does not have built-in Bluetooth® capability, you will need to install a Bluetooth® USB Adapter to utilize the Speakerphone. Follow instruction for installing adapter in your computer:

- Download from the corresponding websites and install Skype, MSN messenger, Netmeeting, Yahoo messenger, or ICQ application software in the PC
- Pair Speakerphone with Computer:
 - o Follow pairing instruction of Speakerphone to set the Speakerphone into pairing mode
 - o Start the computer Bluetooth® software and pair with the Speakerphone
If computer prompts for a Speakerphone passkey enter "0000"
- Connecting and Disconnecting:
 - o Press the "On/Off" to connect the Speakerphone with the computer
 - o Press "On/Off" again to disconnect
- Testing the Bluetooth® Link:
 - o After PC connects with the Speakerphone, the PC audio will be automatically routed to the "Bluetooth Audio" driver
 - o Play some music on the PC by Windows Media Player or other music application
 - o You should be able to hear the music on the Speakerphone
 - o If you can't hear it, then go to "control Panel"-> "Sound and Audio Device Properties"-> "Audio"-> "Sound playback" select the "Bluetooth Audio" to activate the link.

- Now you can start using the VOIP application and talk to your friend through your Speakerphone wirelessly and freely
- Please follow the steps from Speakerphone Pairing & Linking to connect the Speakerphone back to your Bluetooth® mobile phone
