



Bluetooth FAQs

Speakerphones

BT50256 – Yada Speakerphone with LCD caller display

Q. What is the device passcode?

A. "0000" (4 zeros)

Q. How do I pair my phone with the speakerphone?

A.

- Turn speakerphone off.
- Press and hold the on/off button for 5 seconds to enter pairing mode (as indicated by a red and blue alternating LED).
- On your phone's Bluetooth setting, search and add the YD-V2. Note: Please refer to your phone's user manual for the procedure on how to setup Bluetooth devices.
- Enter the passcode "0000".
- The red and blue alternating LED will flash just blue to indicate successful pairing.

Q. Why doesn't the passcode work?

A. You need to ensure that the speakerphone is in pairing mode.

BT30404AU-4 rearview mirror speakerphone

Q. What is the device pass code?

A. "0000" (4 zeros)

Q. How do I pair my mobile phone with the speakerphone?

A.

- Turn both devices off and on.
- Make sure that the Rearview Mirror Speakerphone is in “pairing mode” by holding the “menu” button for about 3 seconds.
- On your phones Bluetooth setting search and add the Rearview Mirror Speakerphone, YD-V16. Note: Please refer to your phone’s user manual for the procedure on how to setup Bluetooth devices.
- Select YD-V16 from the device list on your phone.
- Enter “0000” (4 zeros) if prompted for the passcode. Note: The Rearview Speakerphone will display “Pairing OK” on the screen once pairing has been successful.

Q. Why doesn’t the passcode work?

A. You need to make sure that the Review Mirror Speakerphone is in “pairing mode”.

Q. How do I transfer my contacts to the Rearview Mirror Speakerphone?

A. This feature is dependent on your phone’s capabilities. Please refer to your phone user’s manual.

Option 1:

- Press “menu” twice, a transfer icon with a question mark will appear on the display.
- Press “answer” button to activate and start the transfer. Note: An icon with an arrow and “AT” symbol will appear while the transfer is in progress. When the transfer is complete you will see an icon with “OK” symbol.

Option 2:

- Disconnect from the device. DO NOT delete the bond, simply tell your phone to disconnect from the Bluetooth device (the reason is that it can only have one connection at a time and sending the phonebook creates a temporary connection).
- There should be some option on your phone that allows you to send either your entire phonebook at once, or to send your contacts one by one. Every phone’s options are different so I would not be able to tell you exactly what it would say for your specific phone (refer to your phone’s user manual). Note: Normally this will be under either Bluetooth Menu or Contact List Menu.
- Look for an option that says “Transfer via Bluetooth”.
- Select YD-V16 on the device list. This will automatically transfer phone contacts to the device.

Q. Do I have to charge the device for 8 hours before first use?

A. No. All Yada products come pre-charged therefore it will be fully functional right out of the box. We have already charged the battery for you during production.

BT50664-4 speakerphone- text to speech

Q. What is the device passcode?

A. "1234"

Q. Are BT50664-4, BTS28V and YD-V22 the same?

A. Yes. BTS28V will sometimes appear during pairing instead of YD-V22.

Q. How do I pair my phone with the speakerphone?

A.

- *Turn both devices off and on.*
- *Make sure that the Speakerphone is in pairing mode by holding the "menu" button for about 3 seconds. Note: The speakerphone will prompt you that it is ready for pairing.*
- *On your phone's Bluetooth setting, search and add the YD-V22. Note: Please refer to your phone's user manual for the procedure on how to set up Bluetooth devices.*
- *Select the YD-V22 or BTS28V from the device list on your phone.*
- *Enter "1234" if prompted for the passcode. Note: The speakerphone will prompt you that the pairing is successful if paired properly with your mobile phone.*

Q. Why does the passcode not work?

*A. you need to make sure that the speakerphone is in pairing mode. **Note:** The speakerphone will tell you if you are entering pairing mode.*

Q. How do I transfer my contacts to the speakerphone?

A. This feature is dependent on your phones capabilities. Please refer to your phone's user manual.

Option 1:

- *Press menu twice, a transfer icon with a question mark will appear on the display.*
- *Press answer button to activate and start the transfer. Note: An icon with an arrow and "AT" symbol will appear while the transfer is in progress. When the transfer is complete, you will see an icon with "OK" symbol.*

Option 2:

- *Disconnect from the device. DO NOT delete the bond, simply tell your phone to disconnect from the Bluetooth device (the reason is that it can only have one connection at a time and sending the phonebook creates a temporary connection).*
- *There should be some option on your phone that allows you to send either your entire phonebook at once, or to send your contacts one by one. Every phone's options are different so I would not be able to tell you exactly what it would say for your specific phone (refer to your phone's user manual). - *On your phone’s Bluetooth setting, search and add the YD-V1. Note: Please refer to your phone’s user manual for the procedure on how to setup Bluetooth devices. Once pairing is successful, the blue LED indicator light will flash every 3 seconds.*

Q. Will the headset work with any mobile?

A. *Yes, as long as it’s Bluetooth enabled.*

Q. Does the USB charger act as a Bluetooth dongle?

A. *No, The USB charger will charge the headset only, your PC will require integrated Bluetooth or a 3rd party Bluetooth dongle to use the BT50332-4 with a VOIP application.*
